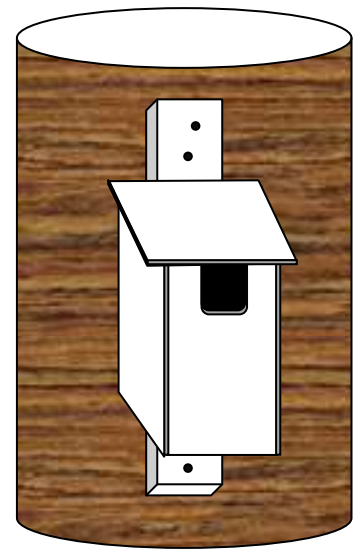
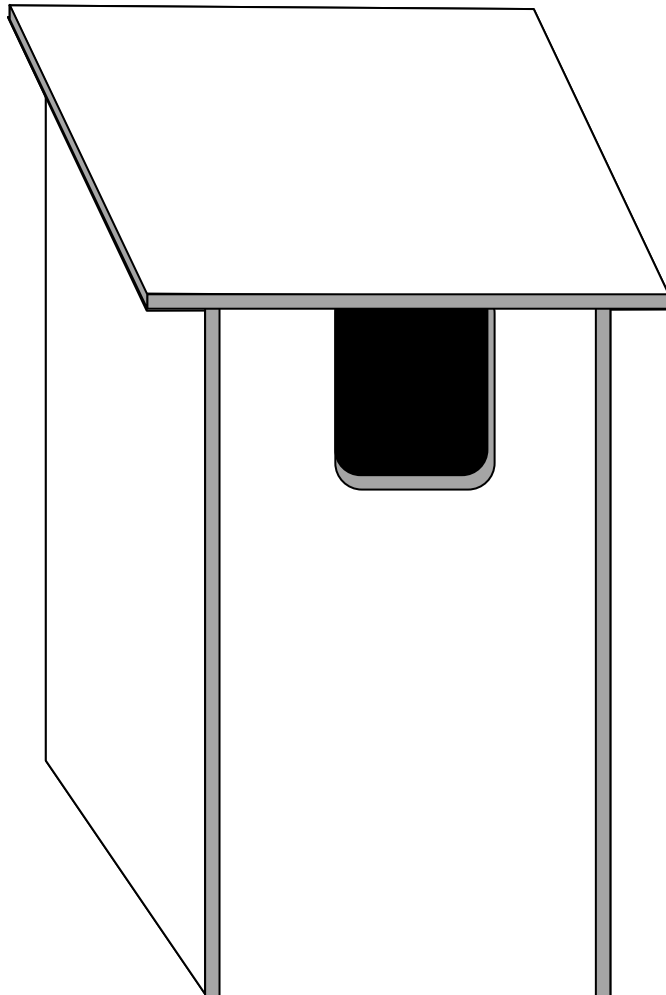


The Northumberland Tawny-Duck Box

For Tawny Owls or Goldeneye or Mandarin Ducks



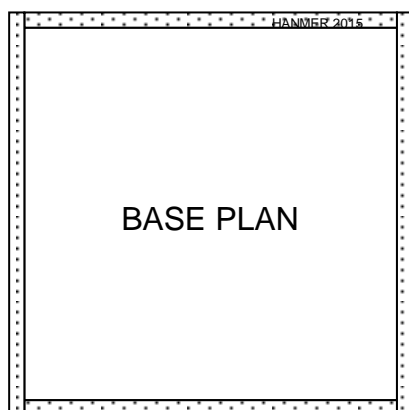
Use 18mm exterior quality plywood or something similar.

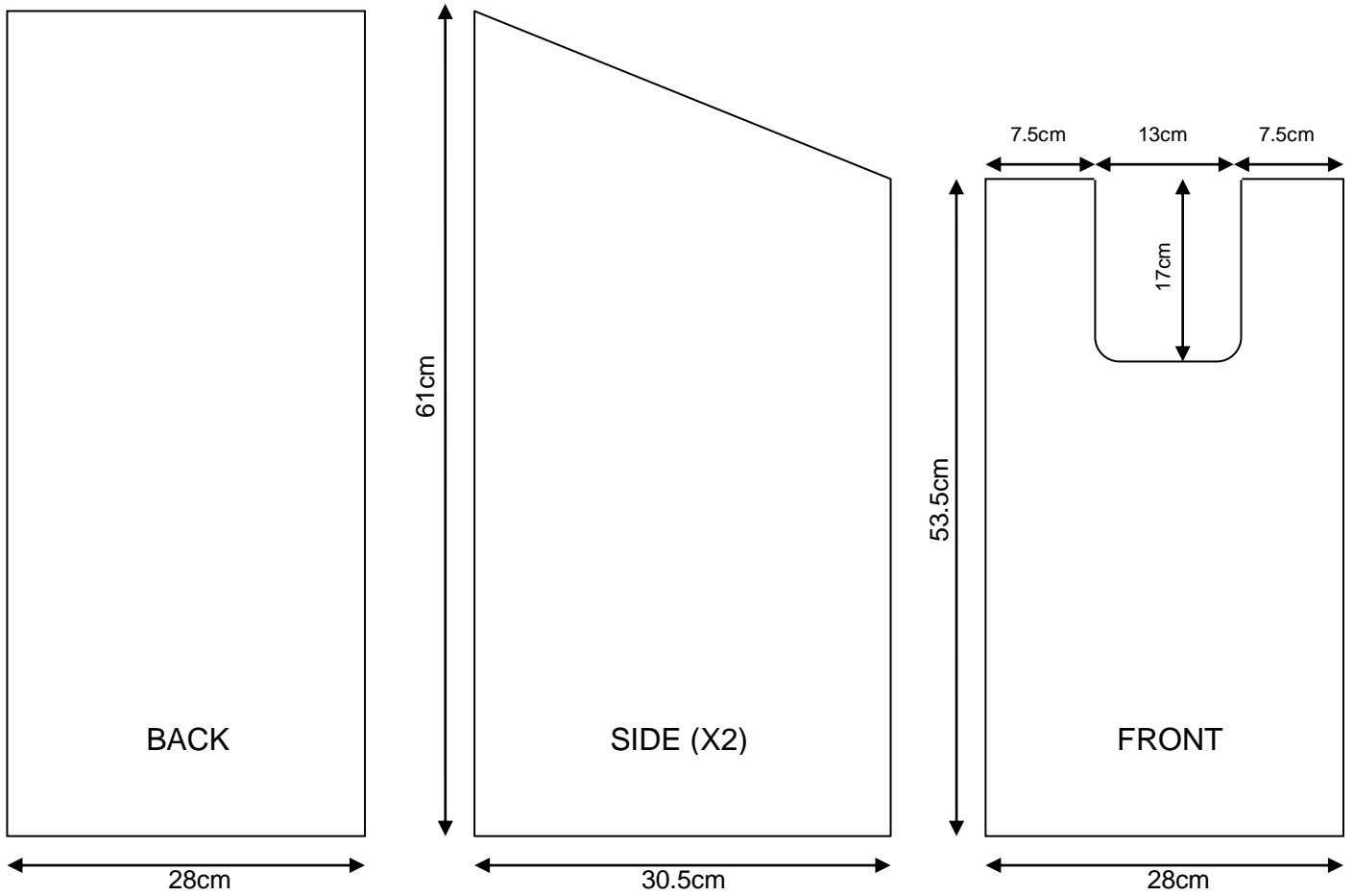
Paint the outside only with water based fence paint. You can waterproof the top/roof with exterior gloss paint or roofing felt.

Boxes for Tawny Owls should be placed in a darkish place in a wood.

Screw on to a batten approximately 1 metre long and attach up a tree; about 3 to 4 metres high is sufficient.

For ducks place near water (but not at the water's edge) and add a thick layer of wood shavings. You should rough-up (or score) the inside front face to help the ducklings climb out of the box.





(N.B. If you expect to attract ducks then 'rough-up' (or score) the **inside front face** to help ducklings get a grip when they climb out.)
